



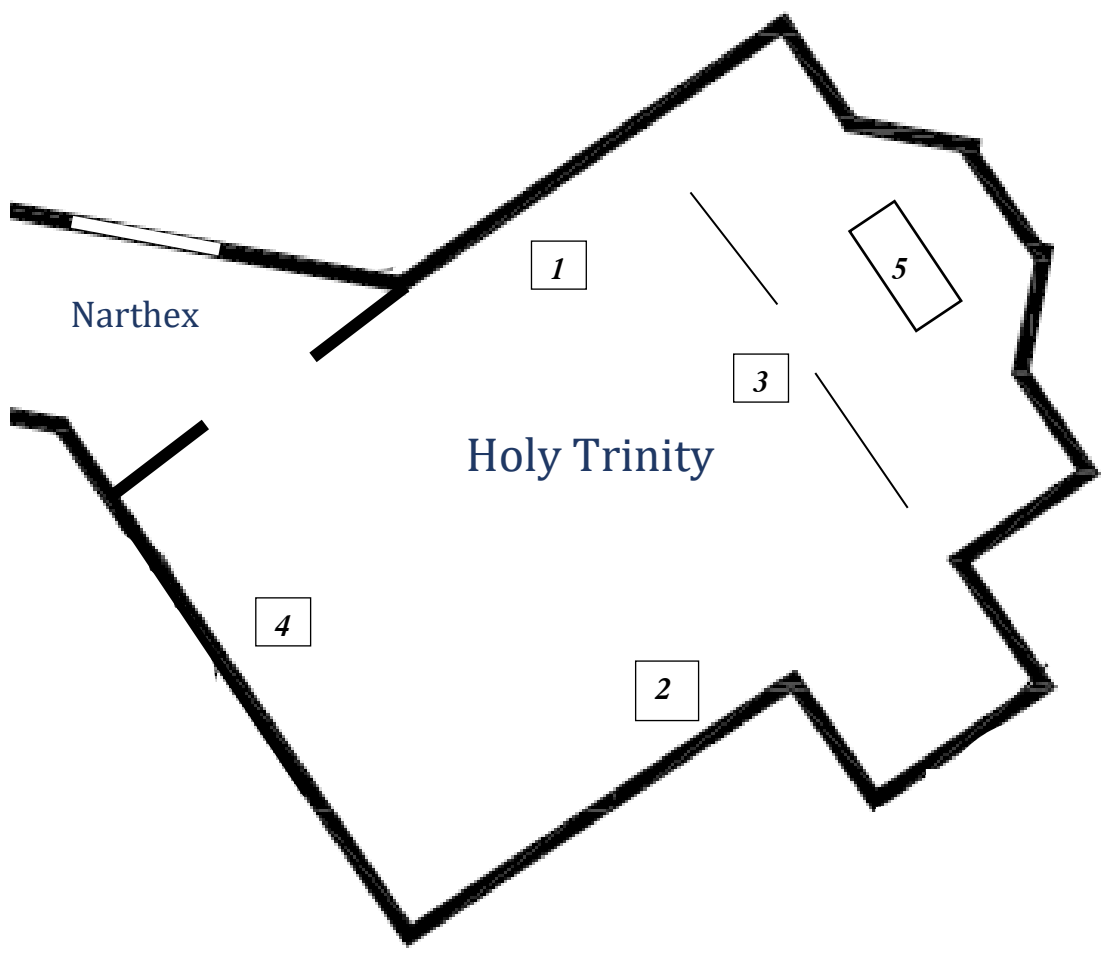

FAMILY TREE

Think about the members of your families or your friends who are yet to discover the love of Jesus.

Write their names on the label provided and hang it on the tree as you pray for each in turn.

Pray they will come to know Jesus, but also for personal courage for yourself to talk about Jesus and to invite others to church activities.

THE WAILING WALL

What are your most heartfelt requests to God for your family, the Church, your city and your nation?

On the paper provided you are invited to write or draw your request to God and then pin it to the curtain.

When you are finished with your own request, please pray for someone else's'.

THE SORRY BIN

Reflect on and pray the words of

Psalm 139:23-24

Search me, O God, and know my heart;

test me and know my thoughts.

See if there is any wicked way in me,

and lead me in the way everlasting.

As areas of sin are revealed to you in you own lives, write them down and ask the Lord for forgiveness.

As a symbol of His grace and forgiveness finish by throwing the paper into the bin.

LETTING GO

Consider whom in your lives you might hold something against. Write the names of those you need to forgive on your hands, and as you wash the names off in the water, ask Jesus to help you forgive them and to let go of any resentment you may feel.

YOUR KINGDOM COME

As you reflect upon the maps and newspaper clippings, Pray Your Kingdom Come, your will be done over the places and situations that stand out to you.

If you are unsure how to pray then praying for the positive - healing, reconciliation, justice, love forgiveness, salvation - is often a good place to begin.
